

Instructional Page for the install of PINWEST's POTD Deflector

The deflector should have come with 2 screws, one longer than the other. If it did not, then please contact us @ sales@pinwest.ca and we will get some out to you.

The ramp is positioned to protect the side of the cabinet from the ball when it is ejected from the vertical upkicker onto the upper mini-playfield. The deflector also helps to randomize the ball to what lane it does down.

The following are pictures of the deflector pre-install and post-install. It shows where the ramp should go. The longer screw is meant to be a replacement screw for the front most post to where the deflector is installed. It is longer to allow for the thickness of the deflector lip which goes under the clear star post.

The other screw is to be installed in the other screw hole which has a cut out in the deflector lip. This is to allow for adjustment of the deflector's angle and therefore increase the variability of which lane the ball goes down.
